## MEMORANDUM FOR 902D ENGINEER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY (ECC)

SUBJECT: Command Policy #7 (Gladiator Shield Program)

- 1. As iron sharpens iron, so one Gladiator sharpens another. The Gladiators are a family. They look after and protect each other. The 902D ECC is implementing the Gladiator Shield Program to sharpen one another. The Gladiator Shield Program is an all volunteer, safe ride program open to all Gladiators and their Family Members. Gladiators who volunteer to be the Gladiator Shield commit to being on call to provide a safe ride home to any Gladiator for any reason, no questions asked.
- 2. Gladiators that volunteer for the Gladiator Shield Program will have their volunteer hours recorded. They will earn two volunteer hours per weekend shift. Volunteers will accumulate additional hours equal to the amount of time spent driving for the Gladiator Shield Program. Hours will be entered into VOMIS accumulating toward the Military Outstanding Service Volunteer Medal. Additionally, Volunteers can spend hours for time off. Soldiers may spend 12 hours for a half day, 24 hours for a three day pass, and 48 hours for a four day pass. 902D ECC Volunteer Coordinator is responsible for administering the program and recording hours.
- 3. The requirements to volunteer for the Gladiator Shield Program are as follows:
  - a. Must possess a valid USAREUR license.
  - b. Cannot be on approved pass or leave.
  - c. Cannot drink alcohol from 8 hrs prior to shift begins until the completion of shift.
- d. Vehicle driven must be in compliance with USAREUR and Host Nation Laws and Regulations with a valid safety inspection and registration.
